Cemetery Prices

Cemetery Grave Price and Regulations

All gray lots on the map are available for lease:

- All lots are 4 feet wide and 10 or 11 feet long. This leaves ample room for a Memorial to be erected at the head or foot of the grave which requires 8 feet.
- Each grave space (4X10 or 4X11) is \$400 (includes \$100 cemetery maintenance fee). Multiple adjacent spaces can be included on one deed which will be issued upon full payment. A payment schedule is available. Twelve month or 18-month options available.
- Foundations for Memorials are to be ordered from St. Colman Cemetery by your monument dealer. Our charge is \$0.75 per square inch of the base stone.
 - Example: A base stone measuring 3X1 would be 432 square inches. We multiply 432 X \$0.75= \$324.00.
 - When we install the foundation, we will add 3 inches of concrete to all sides at no charge. Your dealer will charge you this foundation fee and send it along with the foundation order to St. Colman Cemetery.

Note: At least two cornerstones are needed for one grave. Four may be purchased for lots.

Terms:

- All graves must be paid in full before a Deed/Easement will be issued.
- All graves must be paid in full before a headstone can be placed on the grave(s).
- Grave must be paid in full at the time of burial.
- Headstones must be approved by the Cemetery Board. Please see *Cemetery Rules & Regulations* for guidelines on headstone details.
